Participants must be at least 16 years of age by July 31, 2023. All participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or adult chaperon who is at least 25 years of age or older. Youth groups who are attending must have a minimum of 2 adult chaperons for a group of 1-10 teens and an additional adult chaperon for each additional 1-5 youth who register. All adult participants (everyone age 18 and over) are required to be in compliance with the Diocesan Safe Environment Policies.
