Reflection by Deacon Javier:

This Sunday the prophet Isaiah in the first reading guarantees that God does not forget us. In the Gospel passage Jesus invites us not to trust in riches called mammon, but in the provident God who takes care of creation and all of us.

Those who know me, know that I'm one of those who struggle with perfectionism; I like things to always go well, smoothly, and close to perfection. I guess, it is something that runs in the family. "People often would say to me: "Don't worry, things will work out fine." But we do worry and we can't stop worrying just because someone tells us to. It seems that we are afraid of something all of the time. Some of us are afraid of failure, afraid of letting others down, and of being let down ourselves by others. We may be afraid to love somebody because they might not love us back. We are worry and afraid of growing old and of dying. Fear comes in a wide variety of forms, stress, doubt, tension, pressure, anxiety.

We know that our worrying and fears does not help us, nor does it solve any of our problems. Still, we worry and fear a lot and, therefore, suffer a lot. We wish that we could stop worrying but we don't know how. We find it impossible to turn off our restless minds.

All of us have a lesson to learn this Sunday: "Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; even Solomon in all his glory was not clothed like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is alive today and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you-you of little faith?" A deep faith can put all our normal fears and worries into healthy perspective. May God gives us the grace to trust and grow in his love that brings all things into perfection, so we can sing with the psalm: Rest in God alone, my soul!
